#### **CEO of Children's Specialized Hospital honored**

The Children's Specialized Hospital provides rehabilitation services to children with special needs. Each year, the hospital — with eight sites in New Jersey — serves more than 16,000 children affected by brain injury, spinal cord dysfunction and injury, premature birth, autism, developmental delays, and life-changing illnesses.

As president and chief executive officer of the hospital, Amy Mansue of Hightstown leads the charge.

In honor of her humanitarian accomplishments, the American Conference on Diversity recognized Mansue during its annual Humanitarian Awards Dinner on March 24 in West Orange.

Before taking the post at CSH in 2003, Mansue worked as a deputy commissioner in the New Jersey Department of Human Services, overseeing initiatives for children and the developmentally disabled.
